




English

In English, we will be working on our written skills and our ability to write for different purposes through our topic. Some of the exciting writing opportunities this term includes stories with familiar settings, newspaper reports, diaries, and number poems. Reading for pleasure and enjoyment will lie at the heart of our English curriculum. Children will be involved in guided reading, using a wide range of texts, linked to topic.

They will take part in group discussions and will be encouraged to share their own views and reading interests. Through discussion and questioning comprehension skills will be developed, enabling children to increase understanding and appreciation of literature. Children are actively encouraged to continue reading at home.

Opportunities within all areas of the curriculum will be made available for children to develop their spoken language through discussion, drama, and presentations.



Maths

Maths will be taught as an individual subject and will continue to adhere to the curriculum objectives. Teaching will enable children to become fluent in arithmetic as well as being able to reason and problem solve. Maths lessons will cover all aspects including, understanding number, using all four operations, measurement, geometry, and statistics. Pupils will be extended at every opportunity to ensure their potential as mathematicians is achieved. This term we will be focussing on place value, addition and subtraction, length and height, and weight and volume.

To prepare for our new topic, come in with a newspaper article about a current story in the news, at the moment. The children can read and discuss the story at home and present their findings in class. We will also be finding our about key historical figures including Christopher Columbus and Guy Fawkes. If you would like to research these historical figures and bring in some facts about these people, this would greatly support our learning in class.
