Our Topic

Our main topic for the summer term will be Olympia. We will be learning about Ancient Greece and how life was different for Greeks over 3000 years ago. Children will develop their history skills further by using primary and secondary resources to make inferences about life in the past. By the end of this unit, the children will understand the influence of Ancient Greece on the western world. This is an incredibly fascinating topic, and we aim to make it a memorable one!

Science

In science this term, we will initially be looking at electricity. The children will learn the difference between conductive and insulated materials and will explore how to create their own circuit.

Maths

Maths will be taught as an individual subject and will continue to adhere to the curriculum objectives. Teaching will enable children to become fluent in arithmetic as well as being able to reason and problem solve. Our Maths lessons in this term will focus on Length, Perimeter and Area, Time, and Shape.

Writing

In English, we will be improving our grammar, language and ability to write for different purposes. Some of the exciting writing opportunities this term are Myths and Legends, Chronological reports and Play scripts linking to our Olympia Topic.



Reading

This Term, our class reader will be Percy Jackson by Rick Riordan. The children will engage with this book throughout the term and shall form the basis of our guided reading lessons.

Reading for pleasure and enjoyment will remain at the heart of our English curriculum. Children will be involved in guided reading, using a wide range of texts, both linking to topic and our writing focuses.
