ASSESSMENT REMINDERS:

STATUTORY ASSESSMENTS - KS2 SATs (Year 6s)

These statutory assessments take place from **Monday 13 May** to **Thursday 16 May 2024** and include a Reading paper, Spelling, Punctation and Grammar and 3 Maths papers which are spread over the four days. On these days, the Year 6s can come to school and have breakfast before they complete the tests.

MULTIPLICATION TABLES CHECK (MTC) (Year 4s)

The MTC takes place over a two-week period starting on **Monday 3 June**. The test takes approximately 15 minutes, and the children will have opportunities to practise beforehand. The sound check on TTRS also allows the children to practise the style of questions.

PHONICS SCREENING (Year 1s)

There is a phonics screening check for all Year 1 children which takes place during week beginning **Monday 10 June** and takes approximately 20 minutes.
